"And ye shall observe the feast of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest... and thou shalt rejoice before the Lord thy God."

- Exodus 34:22, Deuteronomy 16:10-11

What Is Shavuot?

Shavuot (Feast of Weeks) is one of the three commanded pilgrimage feasts, marking:

- The Giving of the Law (Torah) at Mount Sinai
- The **outpouring of the Holy Spirit** in Acts 2 (Pentecost)
- The Firstfruits of the Wheat Harvest

It is the **50th day** from the Sabbath after Passover (Leviticus 23:15–21).

What Does Shavuot Mean for Us Today?

This is a day of **covenantal remembrance** and **household renewal**. A time to honor God's Law, renew our commitment to His order, and rejoice in His provision.

Key Scriptures (KJV)

- Leviticus 23:15–21 The command to observe Shavuot
- Exodus 19–20 The giving of the Law at Mount Sinai
- **Deuteronomy 16:9–12** Rejoicing and giving during Shavuot
- Acts 2:1–21 The Holy Spirit poured out on Pentecost
- **Jeremiah 31:31–34** The promise to write the Law on hearts

M Household Practices

- Count the Omer: 49 days from Sabbath after Passover
- Hold a Holy Convocation: Treat the day as a Sabbath
- Read the Commandments: Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 5
- Wave Offering: Present two loaves of leavened bread (Optional)
- Celebrate Firstfruits: Give of household increase
- Feast and Rejoice: Prepare a meal for the household
- Renew Covenant: Fathers and mothers reaffirm their roles
