



The Traditionalist Movie Rating System (20 Metrics)

1. Sexual Content & Nudity

Measures explicit scenes, implied acts, or sexualized dialogue/imagery. *(Includes fornication, adultery, homosexuality, or suggestive attire)*

2. LGBTQ+ & Gender Confusion Agenda

Evaluates whether the film promotes or normalizes same-sex relationships, depictions of “preferred pronouns,” gender fluidity, identity ideology; includes trans characters as virtuous or normal and/or undermines biological realities.

3. Gender Role Subversion

Portrayal of women usurping male authority, men being feminized, or mockery of traditional masculinity/femininity.

4. Marriage & Family Depiction

Assesses whether marriage, fatherhood, motherhood, and family order are honored or degraded.

5. Feminist Messaging

Scores the degree to which independence from male leadership, career-over-family themes, or anti-patriarchal sentiments are celebrated.

6. Violence & Gore

Evaluates the level of brutality, graphic imagery, or desensitizing bloodshed - separate from justified, righteous battle.

7. Profanity & Blasphemy

Counts use of foul language, the Lord’s name in vain, or religious mockery.

8. Substance Use & Addiction

Measures normalization of drugs, alcohol abuse, smoking, vaping, or similar vices.

9. Occult / Witchcraft

Assesses portrayal or endorsement of magic, sorcery, demons, astrology, or pagan spirituality.

10. Anti-Christian / Anti-Religious Tone

Evaluates hostility toward God, Christianity, or traditional religion in general.

11. Moral Relativism

Rates whether right and wrong are blurred or if evil is portrayed sympathetically.

12. Cultural Degeneracy

Covers normalization of promiscuity, vanity, greed, or self-worship; glamorization of celebrity culture.

13. Disrespect Toward Authority

Measures how fathers, husbands, clergy, or law are treated - mocked or honored.

14. Political Indoctrination

Identifies overt or covert leftist, globalist, socialist, or anti-nation propaganda.

15. Race / Identity Manipulation

Assesses race-based virtue signaling, forced diversity, or rewriting of historical/cultural truths for ideological reasons.

16. Modesty

Evaluates wardrobe, posture, and sexualized imagery - does it uphold dignity and restraint or promote exhibitionism and lust?

17. Children's Corruption

Measures exposure of minors (as characters or audience targets) to sexuality, rebellion, or subversive moral ideas.

18. Mockery of Tradition

Rates ridicule of modesty, courtship, father-led households, or religious living.

19. Subversion Through Humor

Assesses whether jokes trivialize sin, holiness, or traditional values under the guise of "comedy."

20. Cultural Revisionism

Does the story rewrite history, race, or religion to push modern values backward into old settings?

Scoring Framework

Scale: Each category rated 0–5

0 = Absent / Wholesome

1= Mild

2= Moderate

3= Heavy

4= Pervasive

5= Central Theme

Totals (20 Categories = 0–100 Possible Points)

0–10	 Wholesome	Strongly aligned with traditional, moral, and family values.
11–25	 Traditional	Largely upright; minor moral/ideological blemishes.
26–50	 Mixed Content	Contains both redeeming and subversive elements; use discretion.
51–75	 Spiritually Erosive	Subtle to overt attack on virtue, order, or truth.
76–100	 Openly Degenerate	Explicitly immoral, anti-family, or anti-God in nature.

Age & Maturity Classifications

Hearthsafe (All Ages)

Clean for every household.

Contains no immoral suggestion, rebellion, or impurity. Promotes virtue, obedience, and family harmony. Wholesome family viewing, suitable for children and adults alike.

Household (Guided Viewing)

Parental presence recommended.

Minor thematic tension or brief impropriety handled with moral clarity. May include mild peril, conflict, or lessons learned through disobedience. Good family film with teachable moments.

Courtyard (Mature Themes)

For discerning teens and adults.

Explores heavier moral struggles, rebellion, or sensuality without explicitness. Viewers should be grounded in traditional values to discern good from evil. Has mature or older teen content.

Gatewatch (Adult Discretion)

For the spiritually steady.

Frequent moral confusion, sensuality, profanity, or ideological subversion. Not suitable for impressionable minds or children. Contains adult-level intensity; worldview-critical analysis required.

Banishment (Unfit for Human Viewing)

Corrupting to spirit and order.

Centers on perversion, blasphemy, witchcraft, or anti-God ideology. Explicitly undermines virtue, modesty, or the family structure. Contains spiritually destructive material that should not enter the home. This film should be wholly avoided or analyzed only for research/warning purposes with extreme caution.
